"Mi papá dice que hay personas y animales y árboles y autos", dice Nyunyu.


"¡Guau! ¡Mucho que ver! "Dice Tone.






A medida que avanza el día, su amiga Sol sube más en el cielo hasta que Tone y Nyunyu y las otras gotitas no puedan volver a verla.

Rebotan en la nube y luego caen lejos, lejos hacia la tierra.



"Wee!" "Wee!"




iSWOOSH!
