



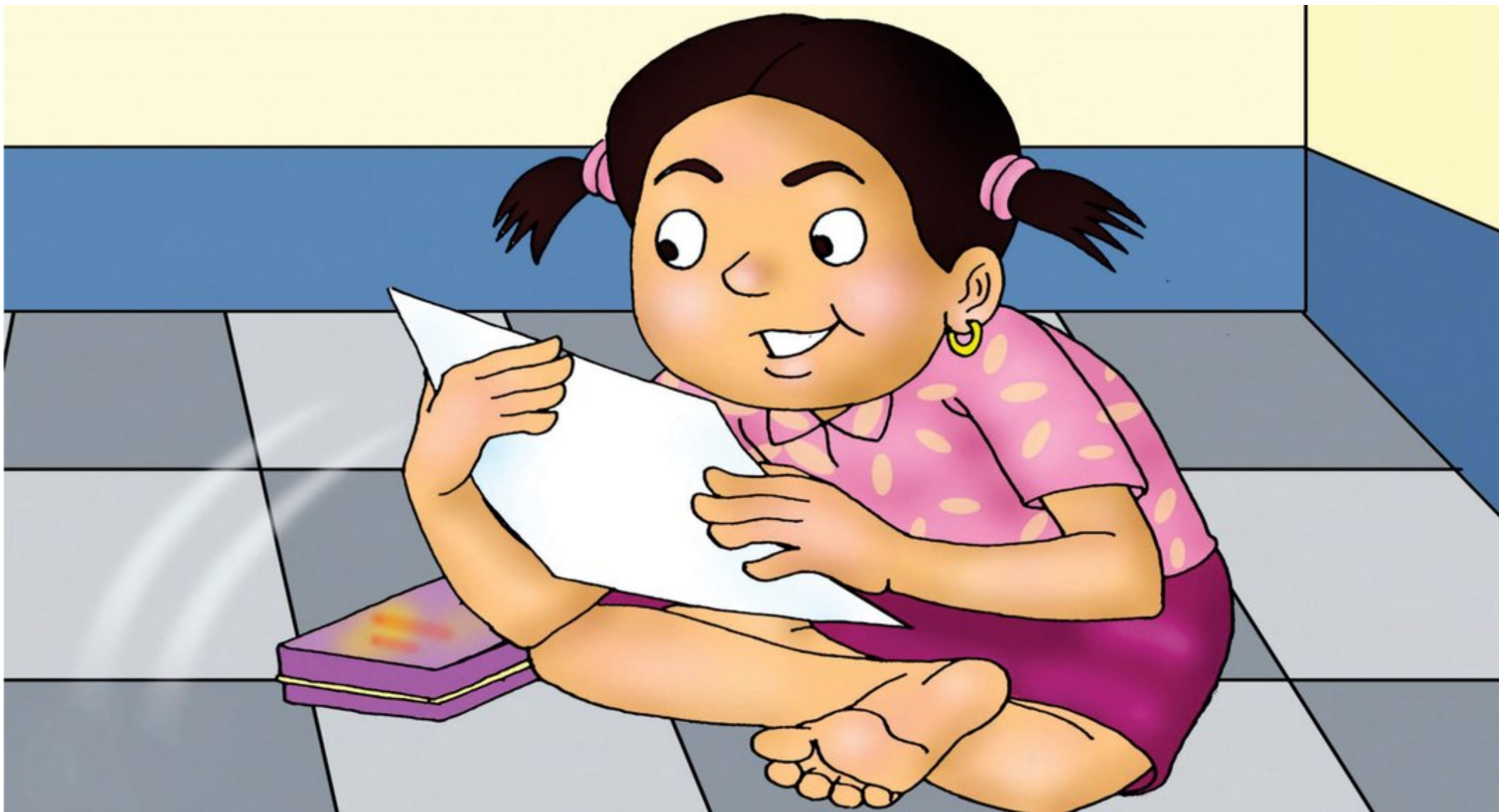

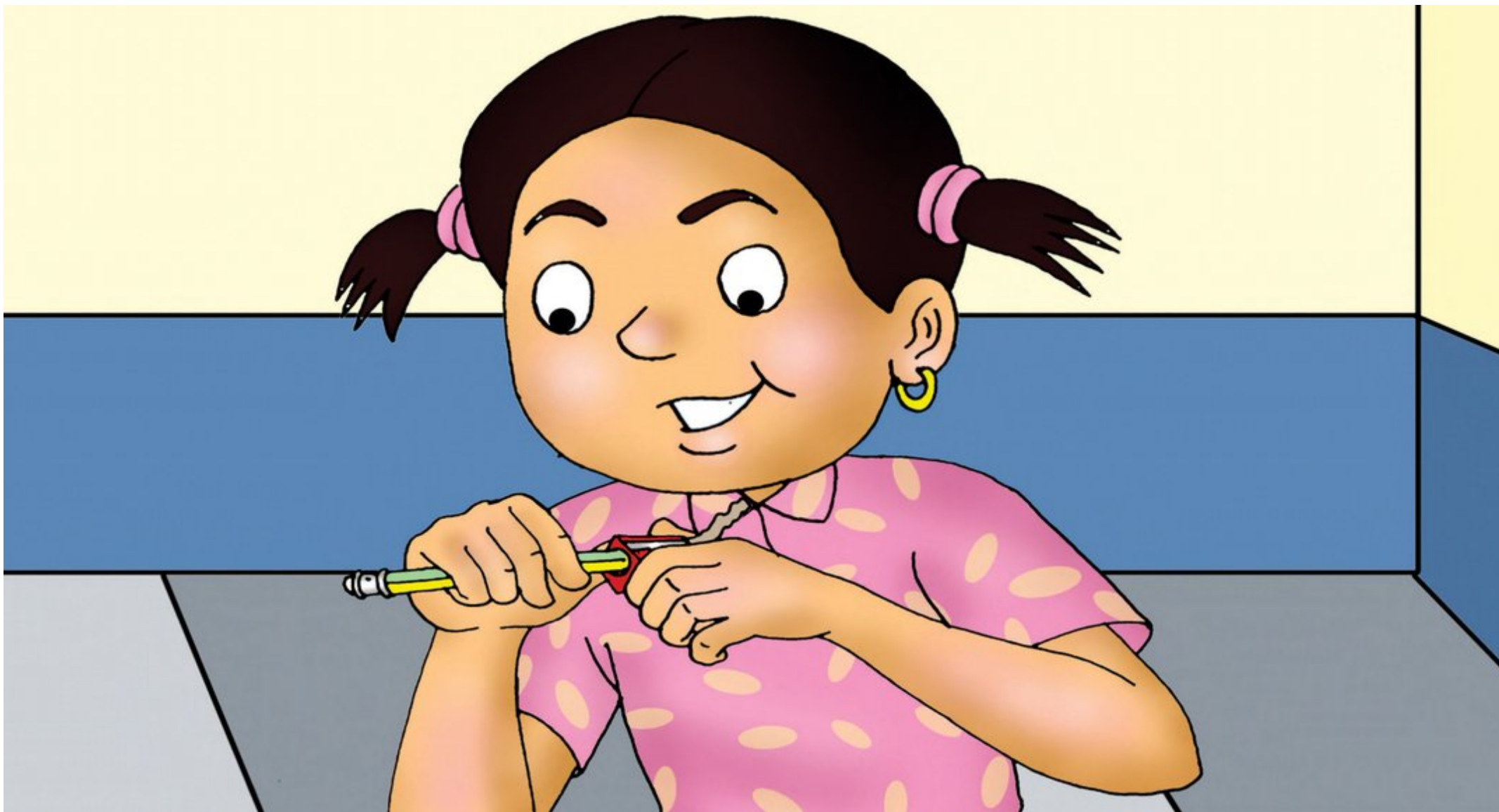

Chunchun le puso el lápiz a la cáscara de naranja. Su paraguas esta listo.

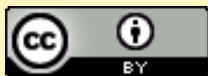
